Abstracts should be written in correct English language, ARIAL font (size 12), line spacing 1, left aligned, without indentation, numbered or bulleted lists and containing a maximum of 2300 characters, including spaces (around 350 words).

Names of authors and bibliographic references are not allowed on the abstract page.

Research, Project Innovation, or Workshop abstracts must follow the structure bellow.
